Event Description:

The UN Secretary-General's Report to the General Assembly in 2011 stated that the post-2015 development framework is likely to have the best development impact if it emerges from an inclusive, open and transparent process with multi-stakeholder participation. In this regard the UN Millennium Campaign is developing and implementing an outreach strategy to civil society, which will provide a forum for stakeholders to discuss key issues relating to the post 2015 discourse including; articulating and defining the advocacy challenge, framing the end game; i.e. what is perceived as an acceptable outcome and the criteria for such outcomes, identifying areas for strong civil society engagement and identifying potential pitfalls in the process and strategizing to address them.

The event format will be an open round table discussion but guided by presentations on; civil society engagement within their constituents, progress to date of the UN and intergovernmental processes, civil society thoughts on the content of a new framework and strategies to ensure that desired results are achieved in an acceptable manner including building on and complementing existing processes and the potential for the emergence of Sustainable Development Goals post Rio. The event is being organised by the UN Millennium Campaign with its main civil society partners; Beyond2015, GCAP and CIVICUS.
